

MARKET REPORT - DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

Consignments from January 30, 2017, from 303 sellers were 1513 head including: 40 Bulls, 275 Cows, 30 Calves, 129 Longhorns, 258 Stocker Heifers, 537 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 143 Feeder Heifers, 101 Feeder Bulls/Steers. Average price = \$638. Last sale = \$657. A year ago = \$882. USDA Market News reported the regional market on feeders \$4-\$7 lower with calves \$5-\$8/cwt lower with moderate demand. The market basically gave back the last two weeks' gains. The futures market took sharp declines beginning late last week. The less aggressive demand reflects the large number of cattle that have hit the conditioning and feed yards over the past 6 weeks. Your local market was unable to buck the tide. In addition to the market's downward pressure we had very inconsistent quality. High yielding packer bulls continued the improvement started last week at \$90-\$95.5. Prices on packer cows reflected high ratio of low yielders. We had more bred cows than the past 3 weeks, mostly older cows and quite a few that should have been culled a year ago. **Our 25th annual "Bringing in the Green" Special Replacement Sale is scheduled for Saturday, April 22.
