

## MARKET REPORT - DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

**Consignments** from March 18, 2019, were 1436 head including: 29 Bulls, 267 Cows, 37 Calves, 120 Longhorns, 379 Stocker Heifers, 418 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 55 Feeder Heifers, 131 Feeder Bulls/Steers. Demand and prices for steers rebounded strongly from last week; 4-6 weight steers were \$10-\$12 higher, with 7 weights \$7 higher. We actually had more bull calves than steers. With the 5+ weight bulls taking a \$5-\$8/cwt discount, a chunk of money is being left on the table. Conditioned heifers ready for grass grazing also had strong gains. Comparable breeds steady. Pairs \$100-\$150 higher. Packers steady. **Consignments are being accepted for the annual "Bringing in the Green" Special Sale scheduled for Saturday, April 13.
