

MARKET REPORT - DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

Consignments from July 16, 2018, were 2310 head including: 59 Bulls, 556 Cows, 127 Calves, 144 Longhorns, 457 Stocker Heifers, 554 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 155 Feeder Heifers, 258 Feeder Bulls/Steers. Nationally, the market backed down from last week as many orders were filled by week's end. Couple that with the extreme heat advisory warnings and the result is many buyers went to the sidelines – having truck loads of unweaned calves to process in this weather is not for the faint of heart and unweaned calves were mostly what we had to offer this week. What a difference a week can make! Aggressive cow herd reduction continues yet the packer market was steady. Better quality bred cows and pairs were in good demand, mostly to ship to South Texas and out of state where drought conditions are not in effect. Most of the pairs sold from \$1200-\$1375 and bred from \$1100-\$1225.
