

## MARKET REPORT – DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

**Consignments** from July 23, 2018, were 1705 head including: 31 Bulls, 508 Cows, 90 Calves, 155 Longhorns, 332 Stocker Heifers, 337 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 115 Feeder Heifers, 137 Feeder Steers. Friday's On Feed Report and another week of aggressive harvesting of fed cattle gave the market a boost, especially for weaned calves and feeders. There is also concern that the big sell offs this past month has cut into the normal fall inventories. 6-7 weight steers ha double digit gains while 7-8 weight heifers were \$1.00-\$3.00 higher. Average prices for all weights of heifers were mostly \$1.00-\$150 higher; significant discount on unweaned and bull calves. Most of the bred heifers and cows were in 1<sup>st</sup> trimester and went to feed lots or packers. Several orders to ship pairs out of state provided a foundation that kept the pair market steady. Packers were \$2.00-\$3.00 lower with most pens full and 3-5 day delays in shipping to the plants.
