

## MARKET REPORT – DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

**Consignments** from August 27, 2018, were 1574 head including: 33 Bulls, 277 Cows, 28 Calves, 166 Longhorns, 324 Stocker Heifers, 400 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 279 Feeder Heifers, 173 Feeder Steers. The market on calves reflected the big drop off in quality as comparable to last week, especially on 2-5 weight heifers while the 7-8 weight heifers were \$3-\$4 higher. Too few conditioned steers to push the market higher. Comparable weaned calves were steady to \$3 higher. The cow offering dropped back significantly as grazing condition improved, ie, 73 of the 96 bred cows were short mouth or older and in 1<sup>st</sup> of 2<sup>nd</sup> trimester. Supply definitely did not meet demand. Packer prices followed the quality to lower levels. *We will have a sale next Monday, September 3 - Labor Day and will feature the weaned calf segment. Also consigned are 25 +/- mostly Black 3-5 year old pairs and a complete herd dispersal of approximately 250 head.*
