

## MARKET REPORT - DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

**Consignments** from September 12, 2016, from 212 sellers were 1043 head including: 19 Bulls, 167 Cows, 23 Calves, 79 Longhorns, 193 Stocker Heifers, 315 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 70 Feeder Heifers, 177 Feeder Bulls/Steers. Average price = \$672. Last sale = \$695. A year ago = \$1048. The bright segment of your local market was 2-5 weight heifers that had strong gains even when compared with last week's weaned calves. Steer prices were mixed reflecting the national trend. We did not have enough feeders to test the market but the national quote was steady to \$2 lower while our 7 weight steers and heifers were \$1.50-\$3.00 higher. Except for a consignment of 10 nice bred heifers that sold from \$1450-\$1475, we had very slim pickings as bred cows and pairs. Majority of packer cows were gobby fat low yielders. **Consignments open for our 24<sup>th</sup> annual "Fall Roundup" Special Sale, scheduled for Saturday, October 29.
