

MARKET REPORT – DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

Consignments from September 19, 2016, from 190 sellers were 876 head including: 22 Bulls, 152 Cows, 15 Calves, 59 Longhorns, 167 Stocker Heifers, 241 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 80 Feeder Heifers, 140 Feeder Steers. Average price = \$683. Last sale = \$672. A year ago = \$981. The national market quoted feeders \$2-\$5 higher than last week. We did not have enough true yearling feeders to take advantage of the demand as most of the 6-7 weights were fleshy calves. Steers calves had stronger demand than last week but as the humidity and heat increased, the fat, juicy calves become less popular and good quality was required to justify the risk. We had inconsistent quality with a higher ratio of Xbred and plain calves than normal – in a tight market, condition and quality make a big difference. Not enough bred cows and pairs to test the market as many producers are taking advantage of abundant grass to put some gain on their cattle before selling. *Early consignment for next Monday include a complete herd dispersal of 58 Angus or Angus+ cows/heifers. 4 pairs now, others bred to 3 LBW registered Black Angus bulls.
