

MARKET REPORT - DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

Consignments from October 30, 2017, from 299 sellers were 1702 head including: 32 Bulls, 289 Cows, 30 Calves, 96 Longhorns, 378 Stocker Heifers, 443 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 151 Feeder Heifers, 283 Feeder Bulls/Steers. Average price = \$675. Last sale = \$667. A year ago = \$620. The market bounced back strongly on steer calves and yearlings. Several strings of weaned calves provided the stimulus. Feeder steers and heifers were \$7-\$10 higher. While all weights of steers were higher, 3-5 weight heifer calves retreated from last week's market. Good bred cows and pairs are hard to come by. We had a few replacement quality young bred heifer/cows with prices steady. We are looking forward to the November 18 special sale to present a very impressive group of cattle for you to select from. Packer cattle continued to reflect the glut of inventory caused by the floods and drought in Northwest. Next week, we feature the monthly weaned calf segment. Minimum requirements are 45 days weaned and come in on Saturday. **Our 25th annual "Fall Roundup" is scheduled for Saturday, November 18. Sale will start at 12 noon.
