

MARKET REPORT – DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

Consignments from November 13, 2017, from 317 sellers were 1853 head including: 39 Bulls, 367 Cows, 28 Calves, 116 Longhorns, 476 Stocker Heifers, 478 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 155 Feeder Heifers, 194 Feeder Steers. Average price = \$664. Last sale = \$727. A year ago = \$653. USDA regional market report reflects feeder steers \$2-\$5 lower, with moderate demand for all except long weaned high quality calves. Unlike last week, DLM had very few weaned calves today. A good indicator of calves coming straight off of the mamas is ratio of bull calves to steers – today it was 55% bulls. All weights of steer/bull calves were lower except 8 weights which were \$4 higher. 4-5 weight heifers had double digit gains. A lot of calves and yearlings have hit the market in past 3 weeks so the demand is more selective. Bred cows were \$75-\$100 higher with 2-4 year olds bred 3-5 months bringing \$1100-\$1375 and mid age cows \$1050-\$1375. *If you are in the market for replacement quality cattle, the place to be Saturday, November 18 at 12 o'clock is Decatur Livestock Market for the "Fall Roundup" Special Sale.
