

MARKET REPORT – DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

Consignments from November 21, 2016, from 268 sellers were 1689 head including: 36 Bulls, 503 Cows, 71 Calves, 139 Longhorns, 273 Stocker Heifers, 345 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 105 Feeder Heifers, 218 Feeder Steers. Average price = \$640. Last sale = \$653. A year ago = \$865. The recent rain greatly improved wheat fields and the demand for light weight calves. Most demand is for conditioned calves ready to turn out. Additionally, with the temperature becoming more consistent, the risk of putting unweaned calves in the conditioning yards is less – driving prices on good 2-3 weight calves \$10-\$17 higher. Prices on other calves were \$2-\$4 higher. Bred cows and pairs were \$50-\$175 higher and packers \$2/cwt higher. For Thanksgiving Day, the staff at DLM plans to focus upon the many blessings we have in this great country and pause to give thanks to our Creator God – we encourage you to do the same. *We will have a sale next Monday, November 28.*
