

## MARKET REPORT - DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

**Consignments** from November 26, 2018, were 1929 head including: 22 Bulls, 366 Cows, 34 Calves, 210 Longhorns, 418 Stocker Heifers, 529 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 98 Feeder Heifers, 190 Feeder Bulls/Steers. As compared to last week, the market for 2-4 weight calves experienced a strong rebound and demand for weaned, market ready 5-6 weight calves and 7-9 weight feeders was greater than supply. However, most of the consignments were unweaned and fleshy with 50% of males will bulls, ie 363 steers and 344 bull calves. Packer prices steady. **Next week 1<sup>st</sup> Monday weaned calf segment offers the opportunity for taking advantage of the increased demand for market ready calves. Minimum requirements to be 45+ days and come in on Saturday. The greatest demand is for calves that have been worked, including respiratory vaccinations.**
