

## MARKET REPORT - DECATUR LIVESTOCK MARKET

**Consignments** from November 28, 2016, from 215 sellers were 1272 head including: 39 Bulls, 254 Cows, 33 Calves, 107 Longhorns, 216 Stocker Heifers, 423 Stocker Bulls/Steers, 69 Feeder Heifers, 131 Feeder Bulls/Steers. Average price = \$665. Last sale = \$640. A year ago = \$853. The calf market continued the positive trends of the past 4 weeks. Demand for unweaned light weights cooled off a little from last week but remains good. Buyers aggressive on weaned calves but not many to choose from today. 3-4 weight steers \$7.50-\$10.00 higher with 5-7 weights \$3.00 higher. 4-5 weight heifers also \$7.00-\$10.00 higher. Overall demand for heifers higher this week. Demand for better bred cows and pairs exceeding supply. **1<sup>st</sup> Monday weaned calf segment on December 5 should be well received. Minimum requirements include 45 days weaning. To protect the credibility to the program, we require specific weaning and vaccination dates. This information is provided to the buyers so they can process the cattle properly. Our last sale of 2016 will be December 19. First sale of 2017 will be January 9.**
